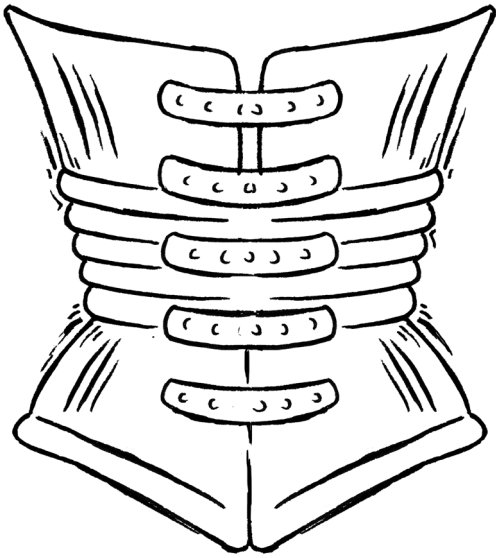
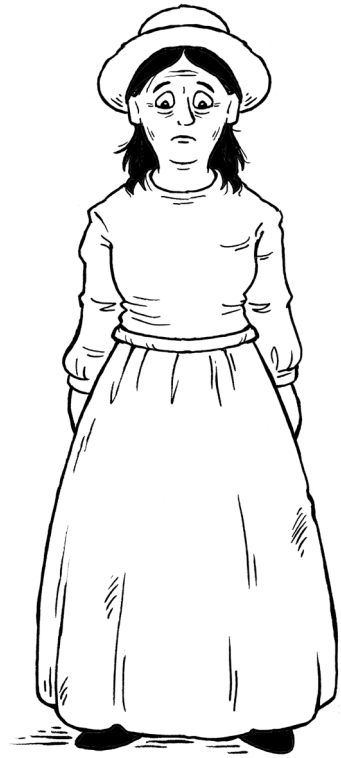


Iron Truss

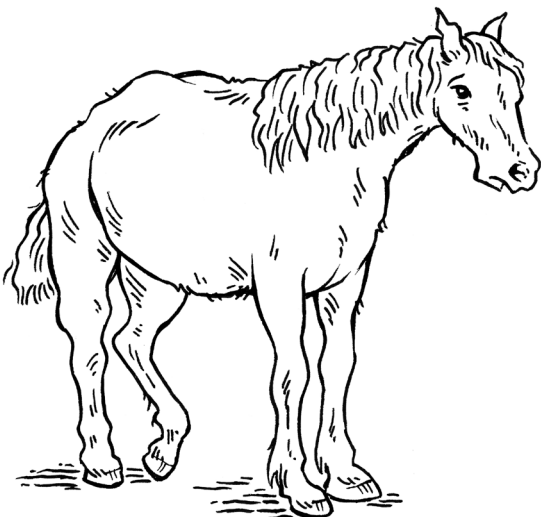
A metal vest that can hold the back straight

Problem	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • His back is broken • He is in pain • He cannot work for a living. • He can only stand when he wears an iron truss to support his back. • His wife has died and he is looking after their small children • The family will starve unless they have help.

Name	Richard Poulson
Job before the war	Farm labourer
Actions during the war	Fought for Parliament. Was injured in a battle and received many wounds.
Problem	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • He was looked after by a doctor for many weeks • He can only walk with crutches. • He is unable to work for his living. • His wounds are still not healed and so he will have to pay for more treatment.

Mary is a character in our film. Her story is based on the families of real soldiers who were wounded in the war

Job before the war	
Actions during the war	Fought for Parliament.
Problem	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • He has lost an eye and his right arm. • He has broken his back. • He cannot walk. • He cannot work for a living. • His sister has been carrying him on her back. She is old now and this is too difficult for her. • The family will starve unless they have help.
Other Information	

Name	Mary Clay
Job before the war	Her father was a blacksmith
Actions during the war	Her father fought as an infantry soldier, defending Newark.
Problem	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Her father was injured defending the town's fort. • He cannot use his arm and so he cannot work as a blacksmith anymore. • The family will starve unless they are given money.
Other Information	<p>Mary's brother has been killed fighting for the King.</p> <p>Her mother is so sad that she stays in bed and hardly speaks.</p>

Thomas is a character in our film. His story is based on real men who fought in the war

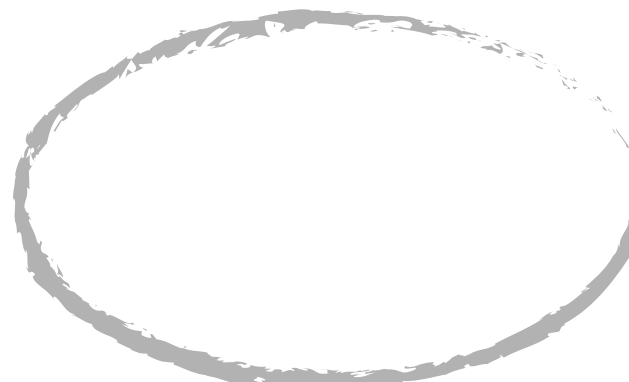
Name	Thomas Moss
Job before the war	Farmer
Actions during the war	Fought for the King. Was wounded defending Newark
Problem	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • His farm was ruined by soldiers. He has lost all his fruit trees and most of his other crops. • Most of his land has been taken by Parliament. • He cannot walk and has no way of earning his living.
Other Information	His wife and children were all killed.



Alice is a character in our film. Her story is based on real women who lost their husbands in the war

Name	Alice Cooke
Job before the war	Her husband was a baker.
Actions during the war	Her husband fought for the King
Problem	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Her husband was killed in a battle. • She used to rent out a cottage, but it was pulled down to make way for the town's siege defences.
Other Information	She has tried to earn money by taking in washing, but she cannot earn enough to support herself.

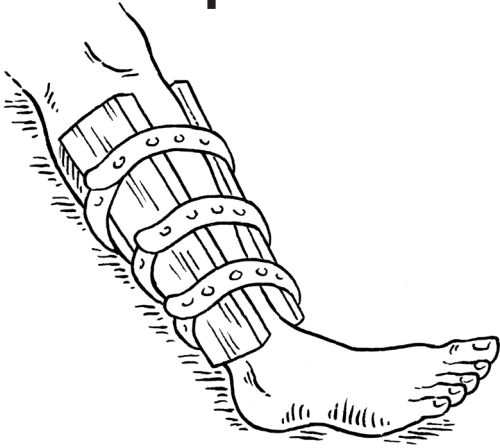


Invent your own character. Are you a wounded soldier or someone who has lost their husband or father? What problem do you need help with?

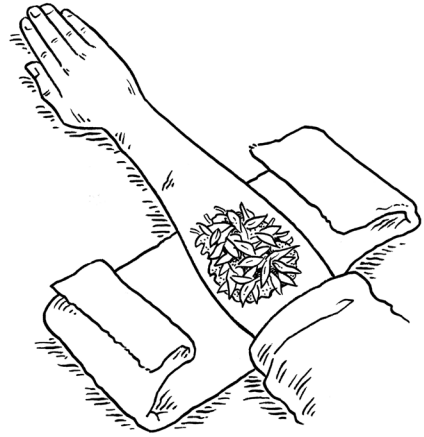
Name	Francis Calverley

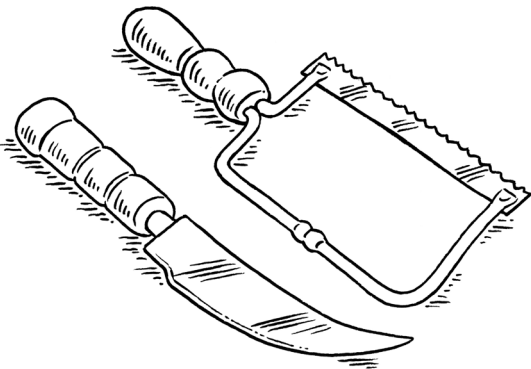
Splint



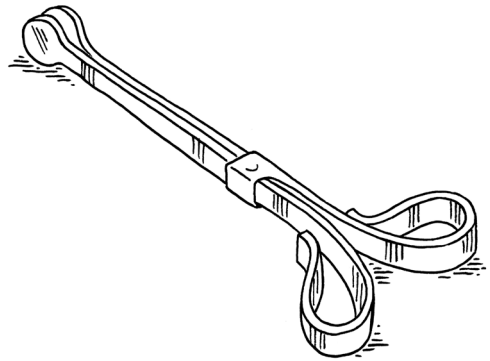
Poultice



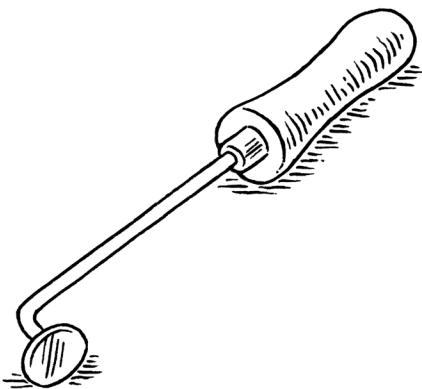
**Amputation saw

Duck-billed pliers



Cauterising irons

Poultice

A soft mixture of tree bark and leaves. Soothes sore cuts.

Splint

Wooden board tied around broken bones. Straightens and supports the bone while it heals



Duck-billed Pliers

For reaching into a wound and pulling out bullets

Amputation saw and knife

For cutting off wounded arms or legs if they become infected. The knife cuts through flesh. The saw cuts through the bone underneath.



Needle and 'tent' bandages

Small rolled up bandages for keeping a wound open to help healing. Needle and linen thread for closing a wound.

Cauterising irons

Heated up in a fire and pressed on a wound to stop it bleeding.

Raphe Cooper

Raphe has lost his eye and his right arm. He has broken his back and cannot move his legs.



Thomas Morris

Thomas's back is broken and he cannot stand up straight.



Francis Calverley

Francis has lost both of his feet.



Richard Poulson

Richard has been shot in one of his legs.
